Family Activity

Directions: Have a "Rock, Paper, Scissors" challenge with your family. After a count of 1-2-3, each person chooses to make either a rock (closed fist), scissors (V-shape with fingers), or paper (fingers together and flat). Rock beats scissors (by crushing them); scissors beat paper (by cutting it); paper beats rock (by covering it). See who wins the most challenges!

Discussion: In this game, you had the opportunity to CHOOSE which action you wanted to do each round. What are some of the choices you make each day, both big and small? Today we're learning that we should always try our best to make the choices God wants us to make!

GRADE 2 - GRADE 5 QUESTIONS:

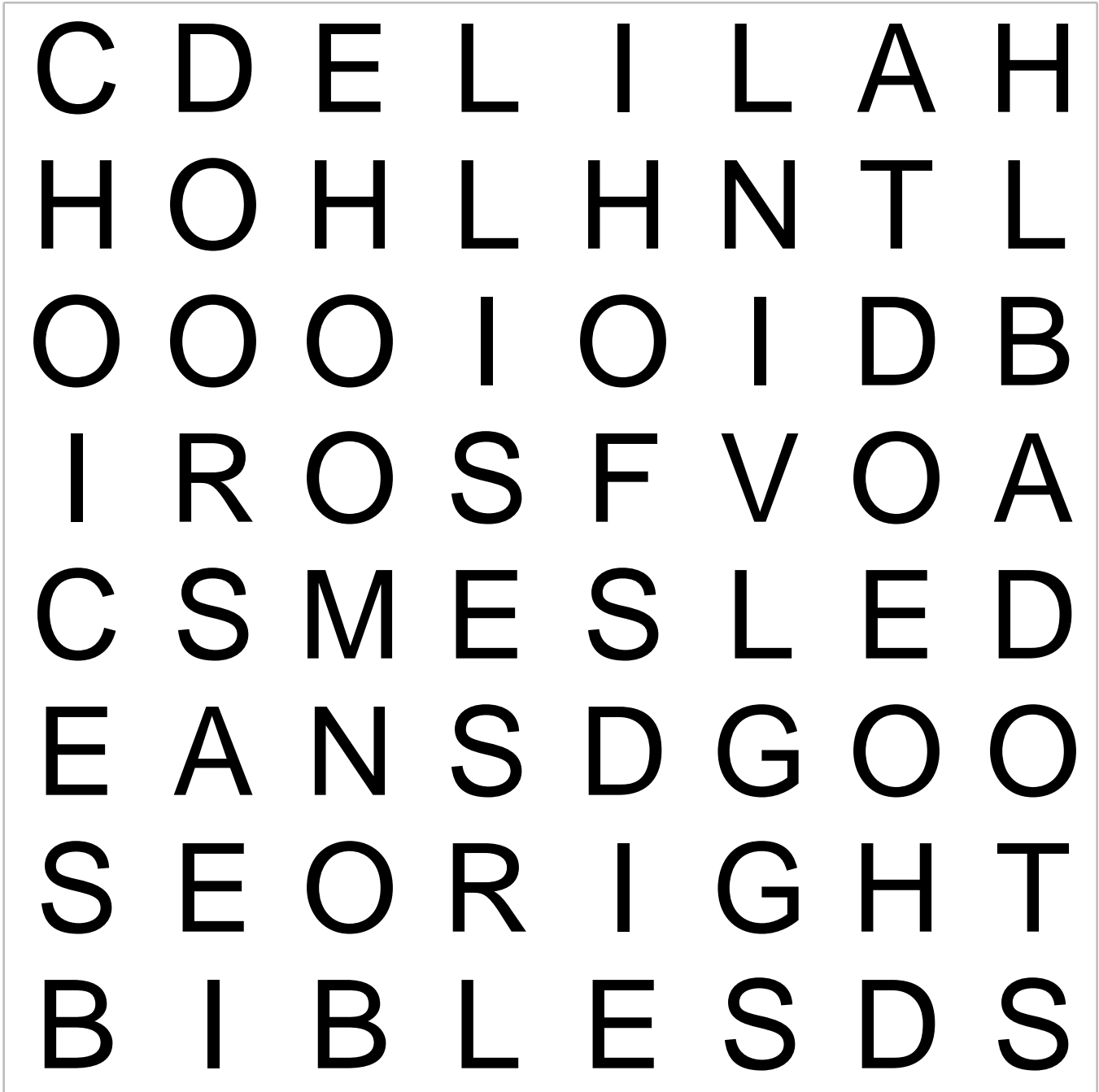
1. Does God care about the choices we make?
