3. Do you have a Bible verse you love or a Bible story you find encouraging? Talk about it with your siblings, parents, or friends.
4. What are the good things that come from reading, understanding, and living out the things like "love one another" that Jesus asks us to live out in the Bible?
5. When do you think would be a good time of day for you to read the Bible?

ACTIVITY - CARD TOWER:

Build the tallest tower of cards that you can! You can work as a team or challenge different family members in a competition to see who can build the tallest tower. Make it even trickier by setting a timer and rush to complete your tall tower.
