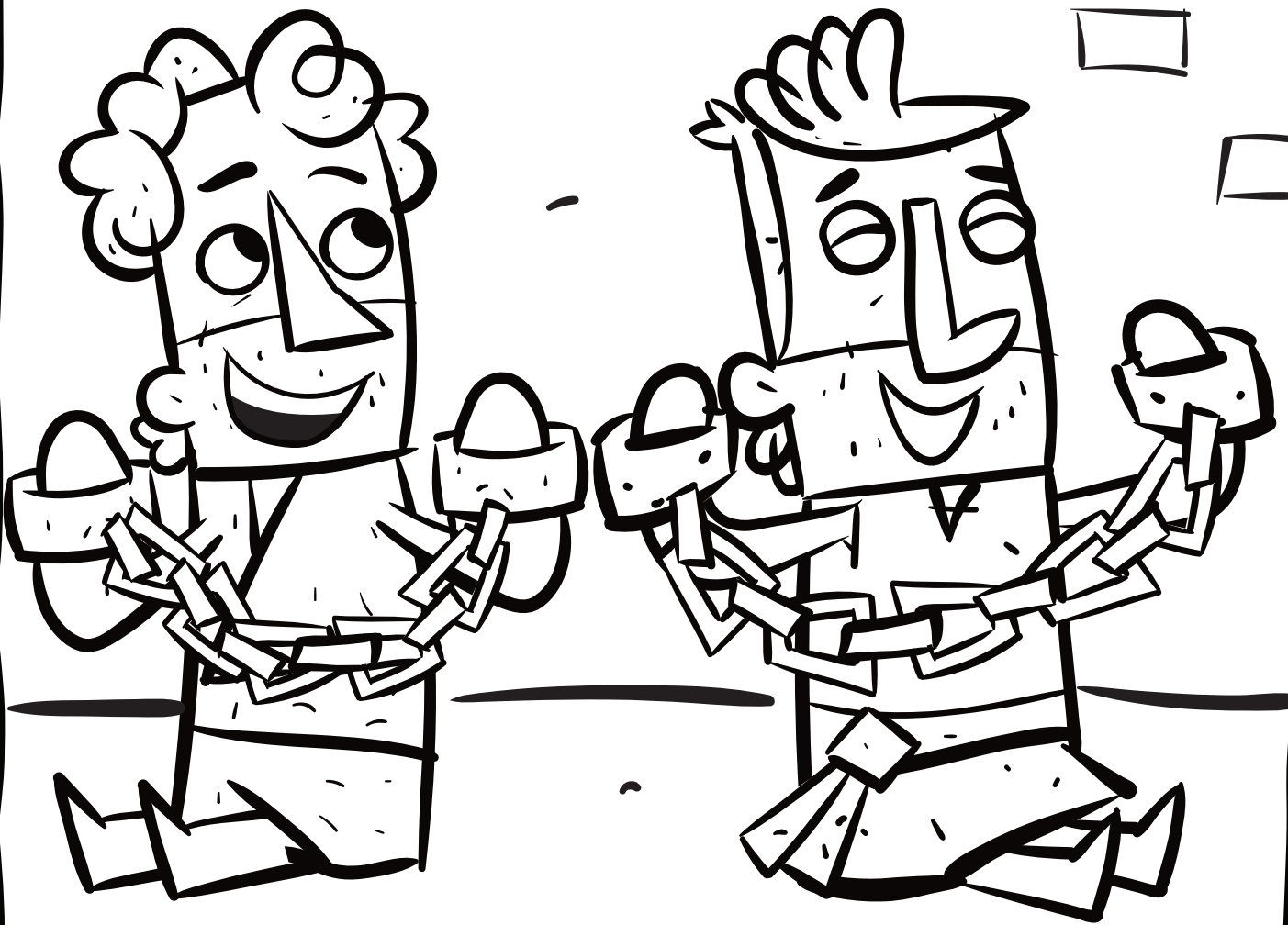
PRESCHOOL - GRADE 1 QUESTIONS:
