


TELESCOPE TALK TIME!

You can HEAR from God!



Discussion Questions:

- One way you can HEAR from God is by hearing Bible stories. Do you have a favourite Bible story? Why is it your favourite?
- Have you ever heard from God when you were listening to a song?
- Do you think God communicates with everyone the same way? Why or why not?
- What should you do if you're not sure about something you think God is telling you to do or not do?



If God would speak one sentence out loud to you, what do you think He would say?

CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW?

Supplies from Focus:


- 2 cups
- string



Instructions:

Following the diagram, thread one end of your string up through the bottom of each cup. Tie a knot at each end of the strings. Gently pull the strings until the knots are at the bottoms of the cups.

Once made, use your "phone" with a partner. Slowly walk apart until the string connecting the cups is straight and slightly tight. One person can put their cup over their ear while the other partner talks into their cup.



Discussion:

One way you can hear from God is by learning what Jesus said and did. How can you learn what Jesus said and did?

It's pretty incredible that 2000 years after Jesus walked the earth, you can still read what He said! Even though He's not standing right in front of you (or connected to your "phone"), **you can HEAR from God!**



ROCK SOLID

Supplies from Home:

- any building materials (such as paper or plastic cups, popsicle sticks, blocks, cotton balls, packing peanuts, containers, socks, etc)

Instructions:

It's tower-building time! The challenge is to use ALL of your materials to build a tower as tall as you can!

If the towers fall, try to build again! Think about...

- What would happen if you put a different item on the bottom?
- Could you build your base in a different way so the tower would be stronger? How?

Discussion:

What did you choose to put on the bottom of your tower? What do you think would happen if you put something soft or unstable on the bottom?

When you build a tower, you want it to be strong, don't you? Jesus said that the man who built his house on the rock is like the person who hears God's Word and does what it says. So remember, when you hear from God, be careful to do what He says! God loves you and wants what's best for you!
