



## GENEROSITY: WEEK 3

Matthew 6:19-21 (NLT)

“Don’t store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.”

### THE POINT

- Unstuff your heart.

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. On a scale of 1 to 10, where 10 = “I want it all,” and 1 = “I don’t want anything,” how much would you say you want and like stuff?
2. It's ok to want some stuff, but when do you think that wanting stuff becomes a problem?
3. Read Matthew 6:19-21. If you were to guess, why did Jesus tell us about where we should and shouldn't store up treasure?
4. What do you think it means to “unstuff your heart”?
5. What are some things that matter more than stuff?

### UNSTUFFING CHALLENGE

Today you learned about the importance of unstuffing your heart. So, your challenge is to race against the clock and unstuff your bag. Ask someone to time you. Once they start the timer, you must open the two bags and start moving the items out of the stuffed bag and into the empty bag. Here's the catch, you can only move/ touch one item at a time. Too easy? Try it with your eyes closed or using only one hand. Good luck!
