



Regathering Hillside FAQ

During Yellow, join us Sundays on-site at Hillside!

9 am and 11 am services with kids & students programming at both.

We are so excited to regather with you, Hillside!

What will Sundays look like on-site?

We're planning safe, sanitized, and special Sundays. On-site services will be live – with live worship, preaching, prayer, and fun. You can choose to attend either the 9 am or 11 am service. Services will last about one hour. The services are identical. On-site programming for children and students (Birth to Grade 12) will be offered during both services with pre-registration required for all ages. Physical distancing (2 metres) and masks are mandatory on-site at Hillside, except for children age 2 and under and when children (Age 3 to Grade 5) are in their assigned bubble in their classroom space. All ages, including adults, will be following COVID protocols to keep each other and our community safe.

Is pre-registration required?

Yes! Please register ahead. Pre-registration allows Hillside to fulfill the New Brunswick requirement to have contact tracing information for you should the need arise.

You can pre-register from Monday morning through until Saturday noon for the upcoming Sunday. Click on the link on our [website](#) that says, "Register for On-site Service."

Seating is limited so register early! If something changes and you cannot make it, please let us (Jocelyn@Hillsidemoncton.org) know so we can fill your seat.

What if I'm not comfortable coming on-site yet?

We understand! That's OK! Please do what you feel is best for you and your family at this time.

The services will be simultaneously live streamed so when you watch online, you'll see exactly the same thing going on in the auditorium live.

What is offered for Kids and Students on-site?

We are excited to regather kids and students for Sunday programming.

Kids (Birth to Grade 5) must be pre-register. Click on the link on our [website](#) that says, "Register for On-site Hillside Kids."

For kids (Birth to Grade 5) a one-time parent consent form agreeing to pre-screen your children is also required [HERE](#). Note: If you have already completed this form, you do not need to fill this specific form out again.

Students (Grade 6 to 12) must be pre-registered. Click on the link on our [website](#) that says, “Register for The Vibe On-site.”

For Kids Birth to Pre-K, Waumba Land will be open with kids in age-specific bubbles. Pre-registration is required with a one-time requirement of a parent consent form. Waumba Land kids will be well looked after in a safe and sanitized environment.

For Kids Kindergarten to Grade 5, kids will be put in a max 15-person bubble by grade group on a first come, first served basis. Pre-registration is required with a one-time requirement of a parent consent form. There will be no large group gatherings with all kids. They will remain in their bubble in their separate spaces for the duration of the program. Within their bubble, kids will not be required to wear masks (but may do so if desired); however, they are required to wear masks within the rest of the Hillside building. Kids will enjoy a great program that includes stories, songs, games, and great Bible teaching.

For Students Grade 6 to 12, The Vibe will take place in the Family Centre with live worship, great teaching, and fun times. Students will be required to pre-register and wear a mask while in the church. Students will enter and exit through the outside doors of the Family Centre - it will be clearly marked by HSM flags. Students will have to check-in upon entry, so come early!

Are masks required on-site?

Yes. Masks that cover the nose and mouth are required at all times on-site as well as maintaining 2 metre of physical distancing, the exception being that children birth to 2 do not need to wear a mask. Furthermore, kids (Age 3 to Grade 5) do not need to wear a mask while in their bubble space (designated classroom or area) – they do, however, need to wear a mask anywhere outside of their bubble area.

What are you doing to make it safer?

Cleaning and sanitizing are taking place between services in all spaces where adults, kids, and students were present. Extra cleaning and sanitizing are taking place leading up to Sunday. Physical distancing will be practiced between family bubbles/Steady 15; and seating has been arranged to allow for physical distancing, even while masks are mandatory. Are other Hillside groups allowed to meet on-site now too?

In terms of the use of our facility during COVID, figuring out Sunday mornings is the top priority over the next number of weeks. With physical distancing and masks, very few rooms are actually functional and available for groups during COVID. As such, these rooms need to be carefully monitored and cleaned. All outside bookings and rentals are cancelled until further notice. Furthermore, affinity groups and Growth Groups are asked not to use rooms on-site at this time. Currently any on-site ministries are to be solely for:

- i. Staff meetings/gatherings,
- ii. Staff online production purposes (e.g. recording, studio audience),
- iii. Hillside Sunday Services/Programming,
- iv. Family Events led by the Staff Premier Family Ministry Team, once per month or less,
- v. Sonshine Kids Academy,
- vi. Staff-led drive-through events,

vii. Two key care ministries where physical presence is essential.

We are so thankful for the way ministry groups, Growth Groups, and Huddles have been creative in meeting safely in their Steady15 or online. If we can help your group get set-up online (e.g. on Zoom) or figure out safely meeting in person, please let us know. We are happy to help navigate a way forward. We are so thankful to each of you that gives leadership to creating connection and community!

One, final reminder, please pre-register if you are attending on-site services!
